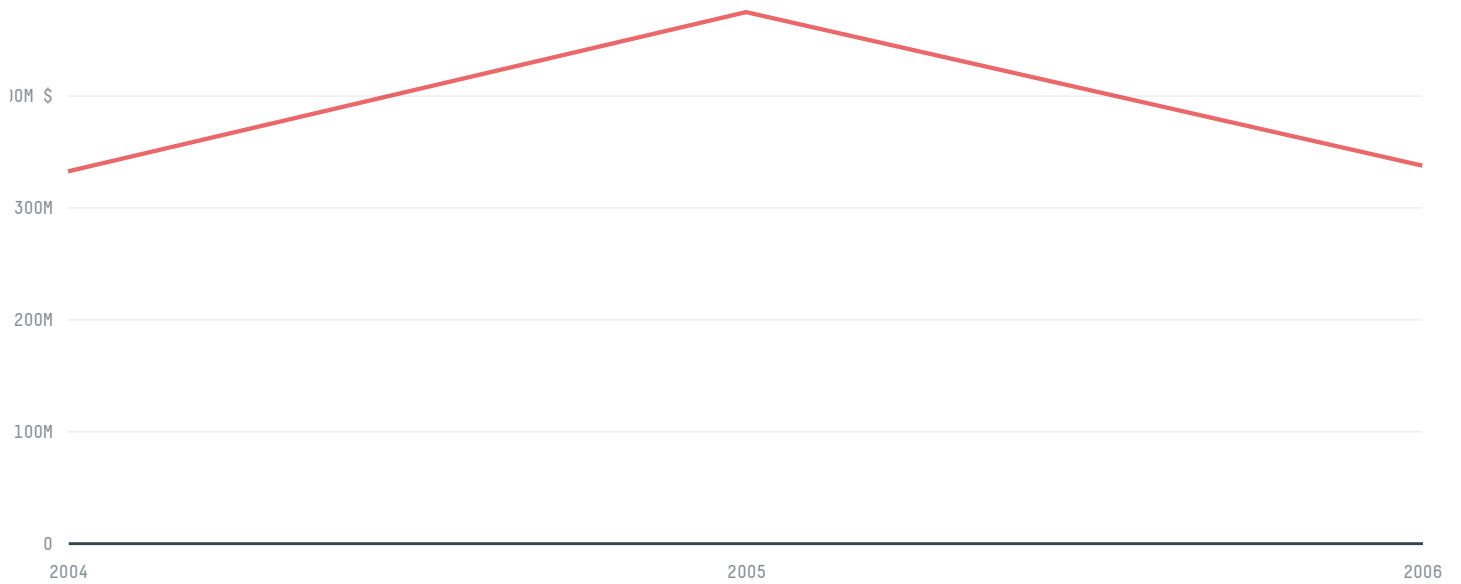

TOP EXPORT TRADERS OF WOOD PULP IN CUBA IN 2017

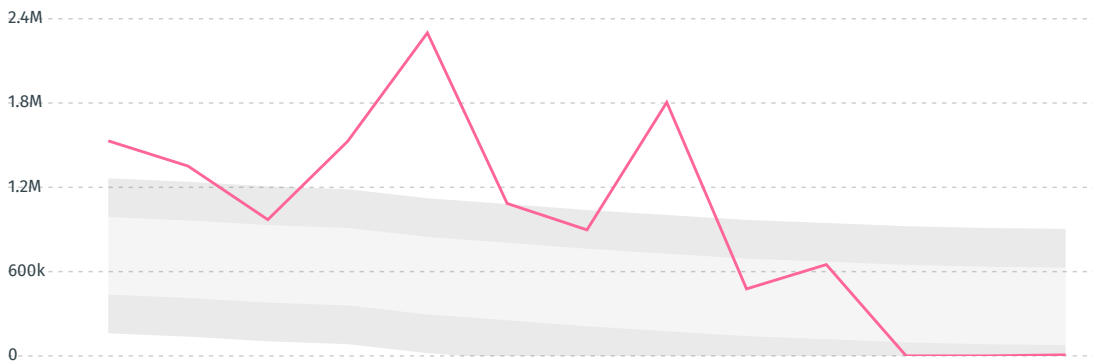


TOP EXPORT COUNTRIES OF WOOD PULP TO CUBA IN 2017
