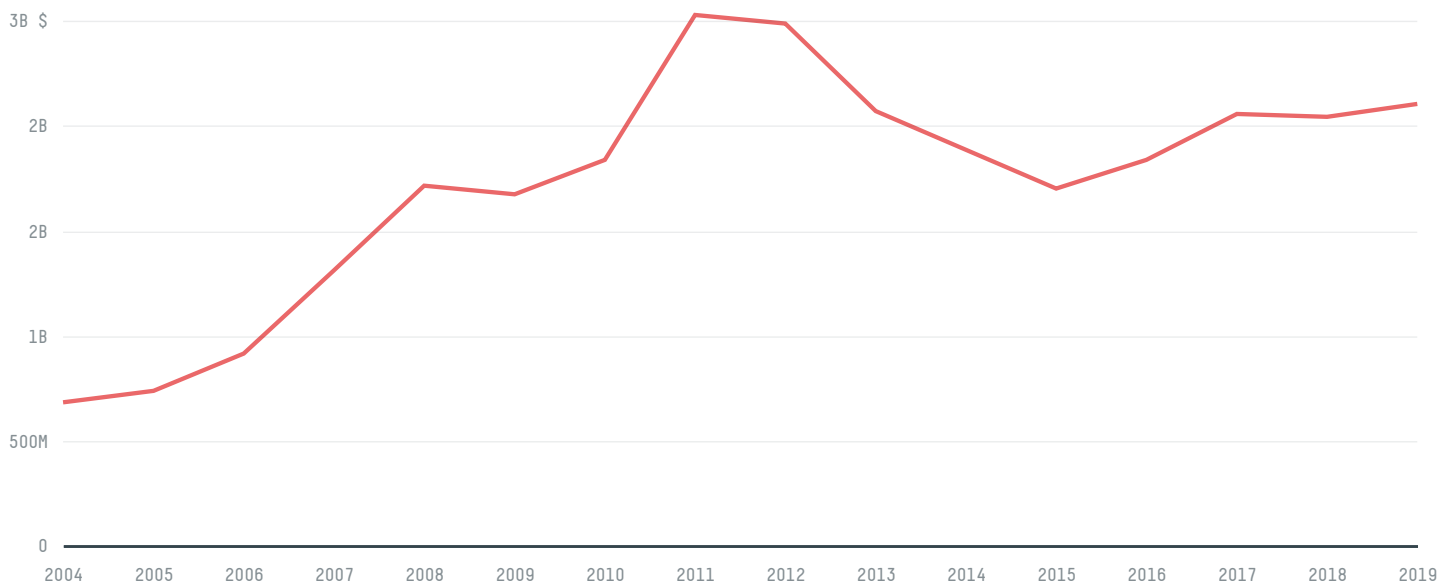

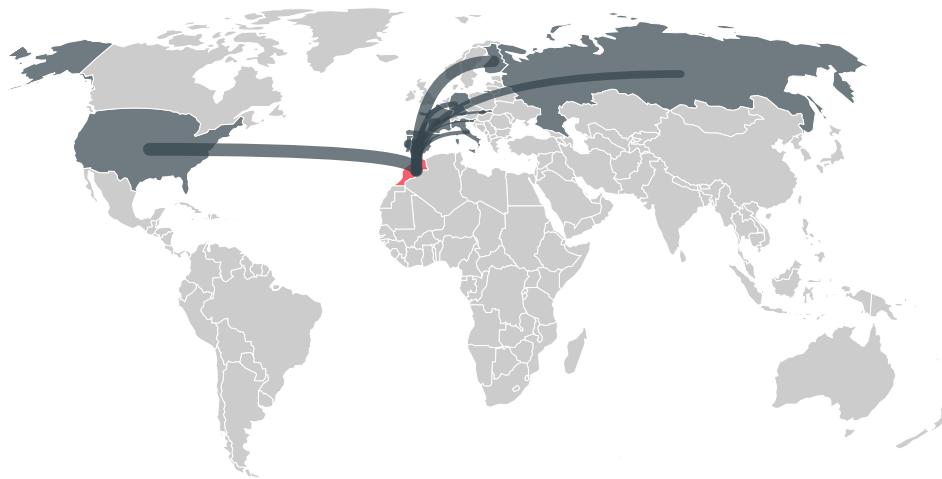
## IMPORT TRAJECTORY OF MOROCCO



## TOP EXPORT TRADERS OF WOOD PULP IN MOROCCO IN 2017



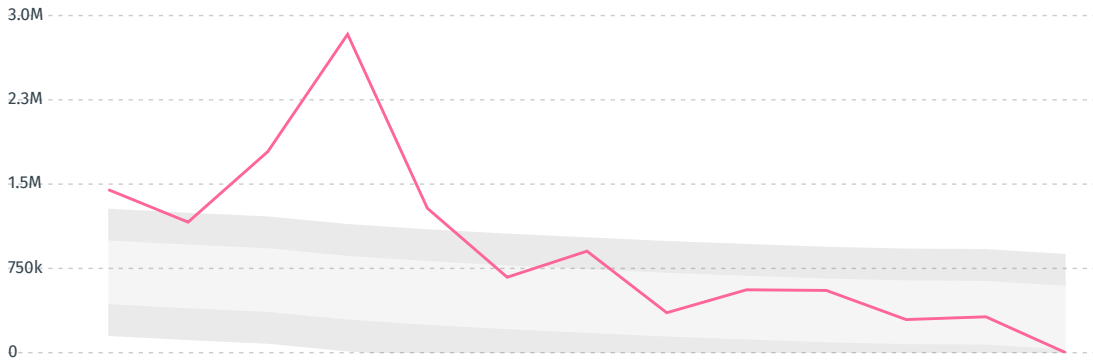
