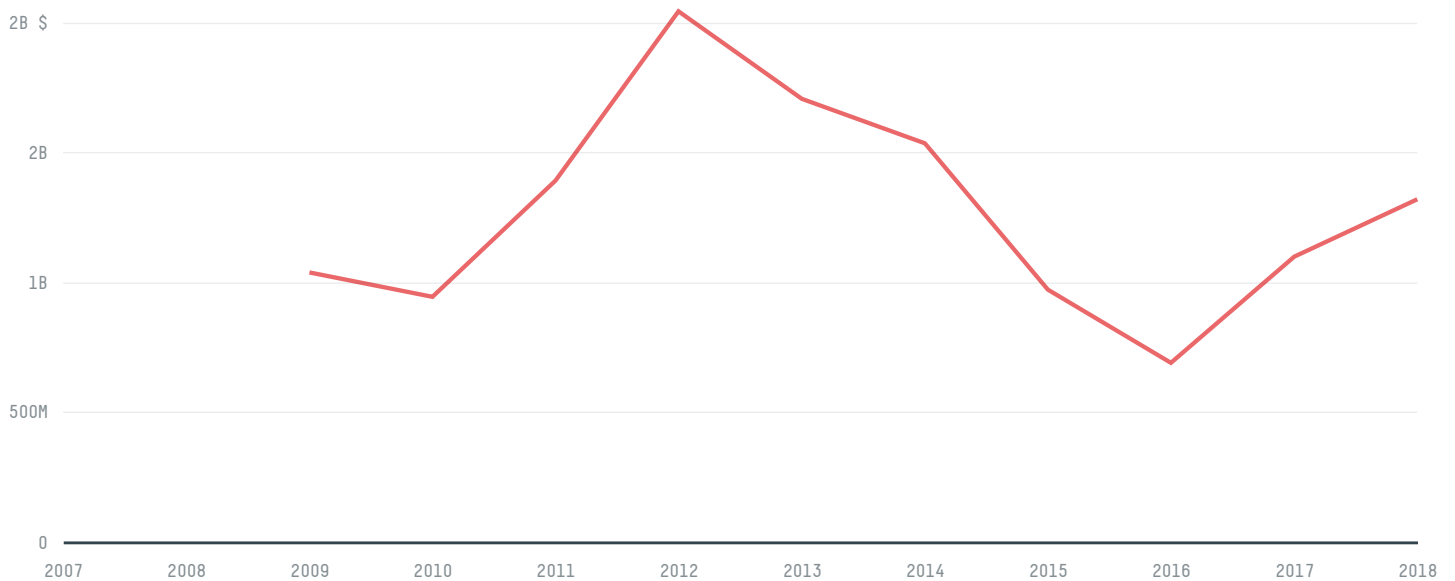

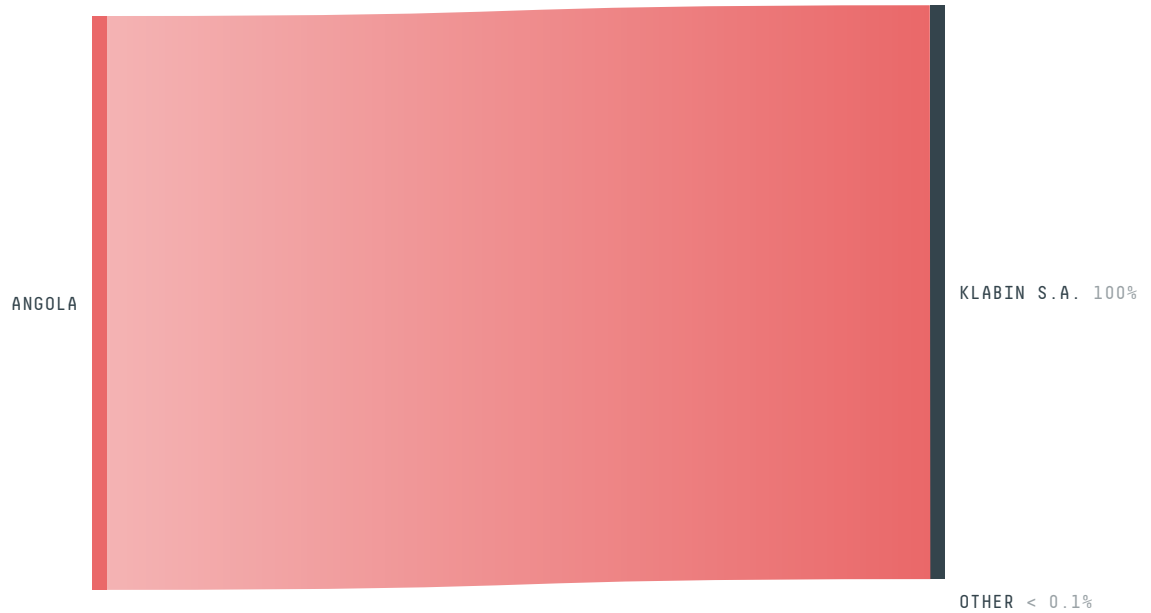

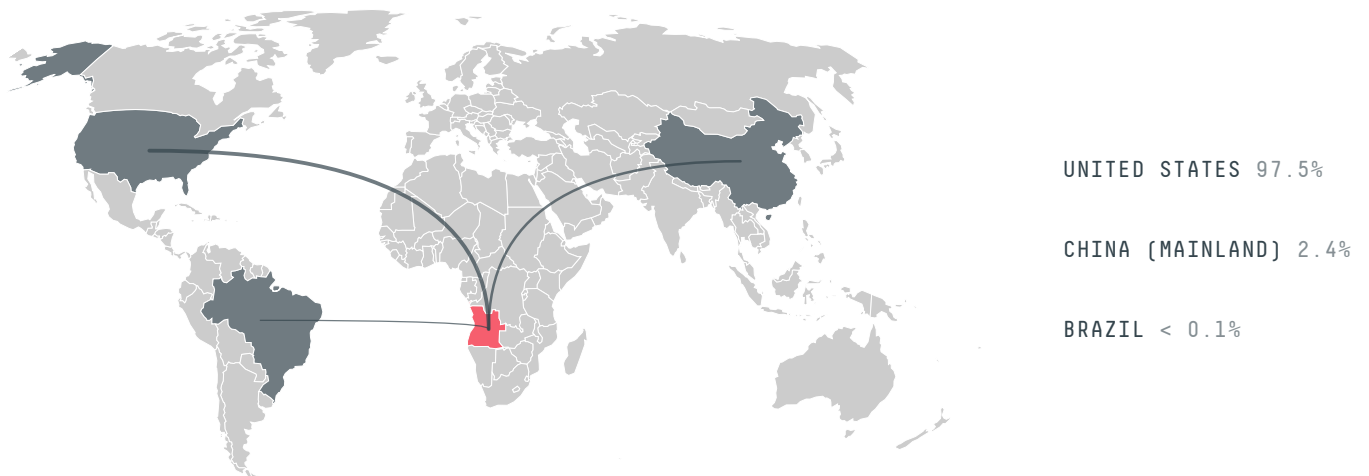
## IMPORT TRAJECTORY OF ANGOLA
