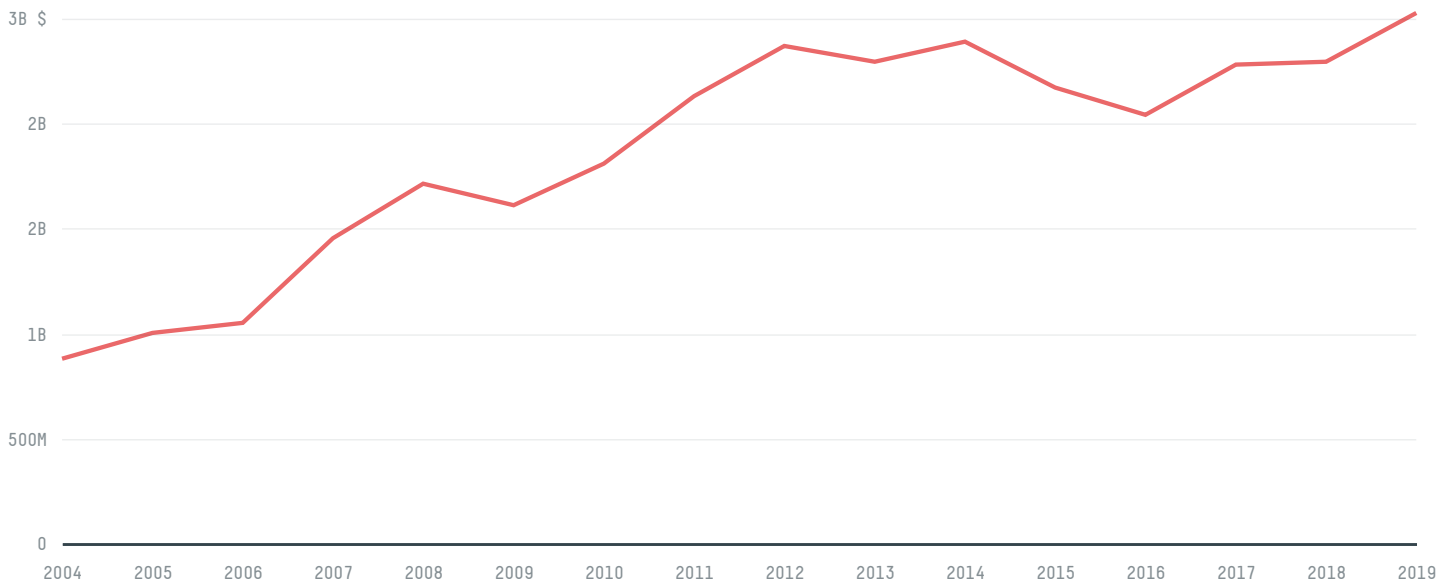

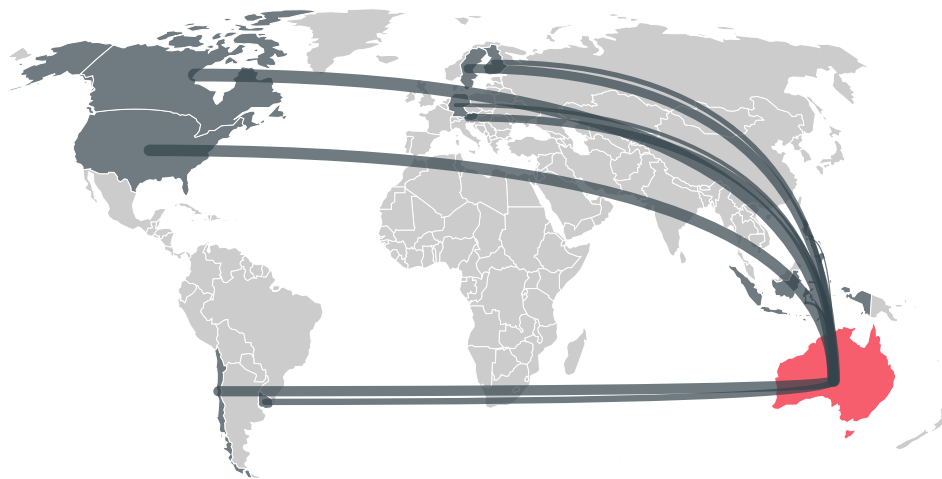
IMPORT TRAJECTORY OF AUSTRALIA
