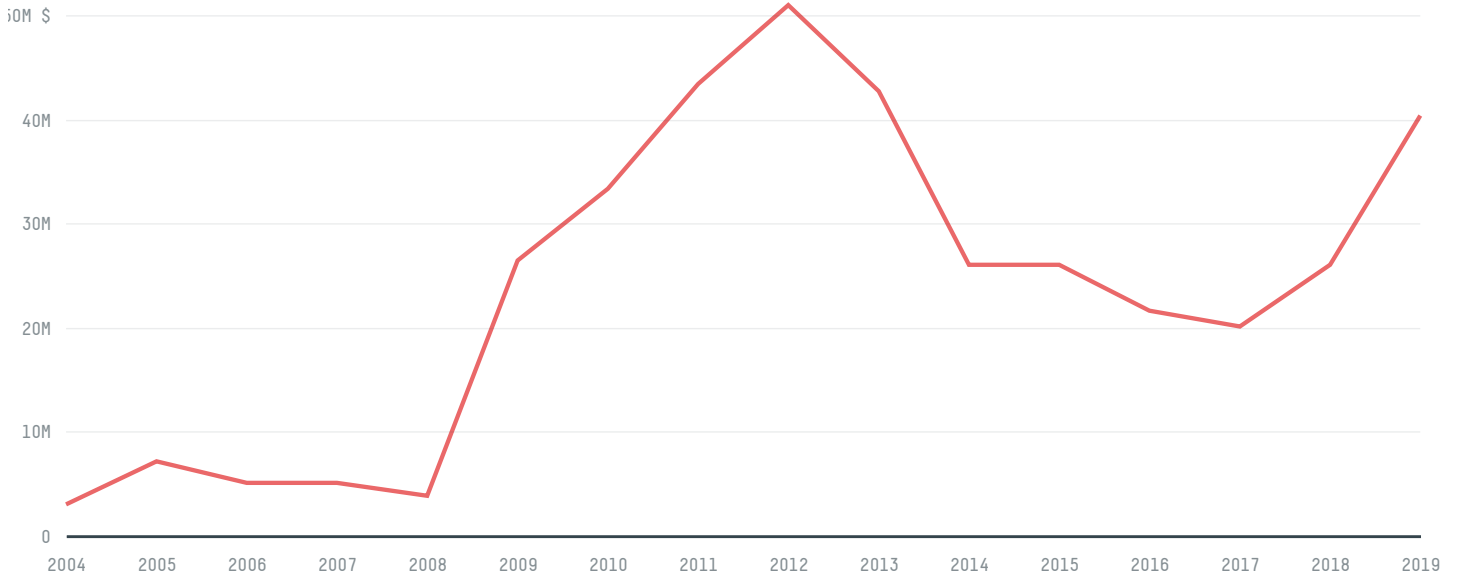

## IMPORT TRAJECTORY OF GUYANA

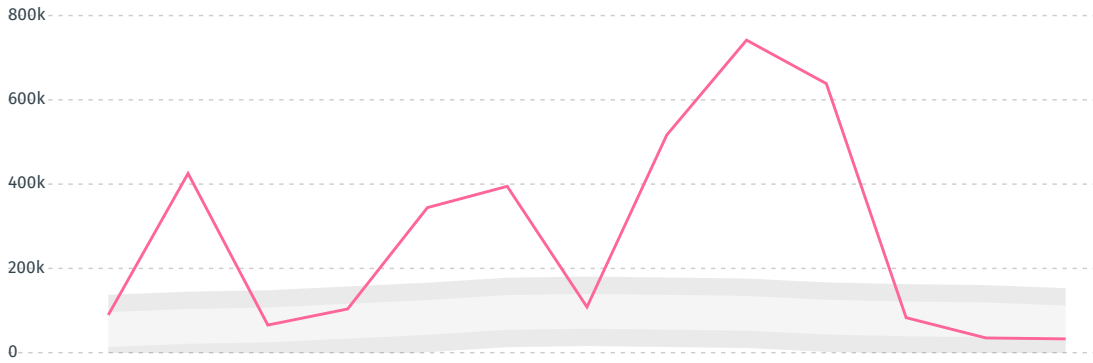


## TOP EXPORT TRADERS OF CORN IN GUYANA IN 2016
