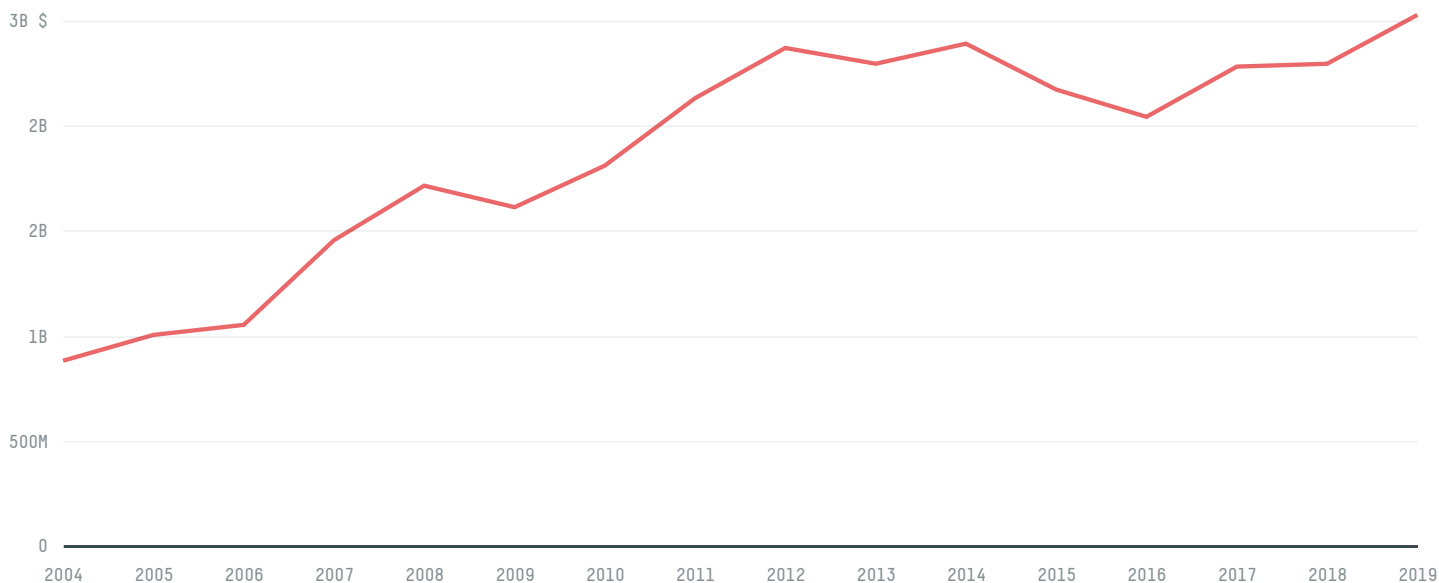

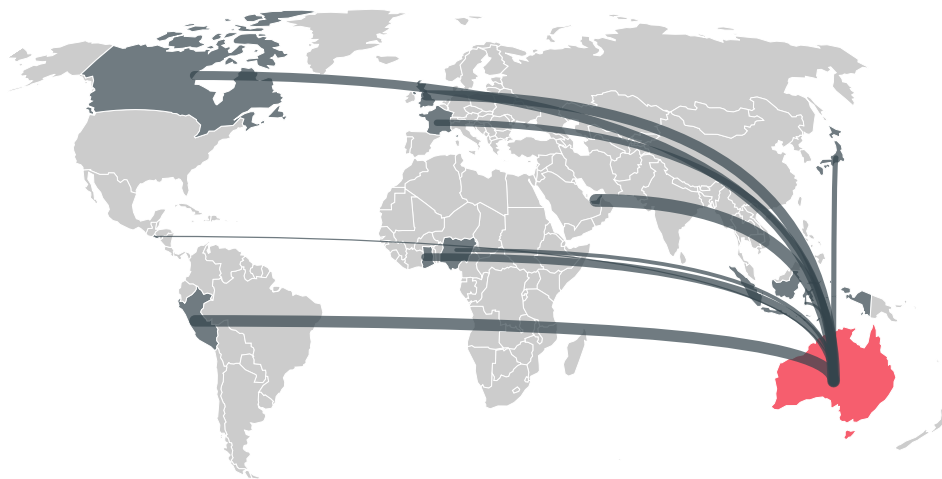
## IMPORT TRAJECTORY OF AUSTRALIA

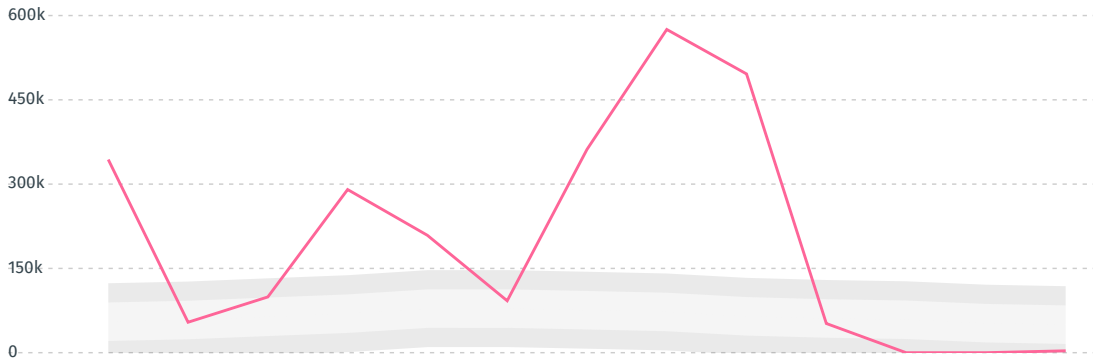
