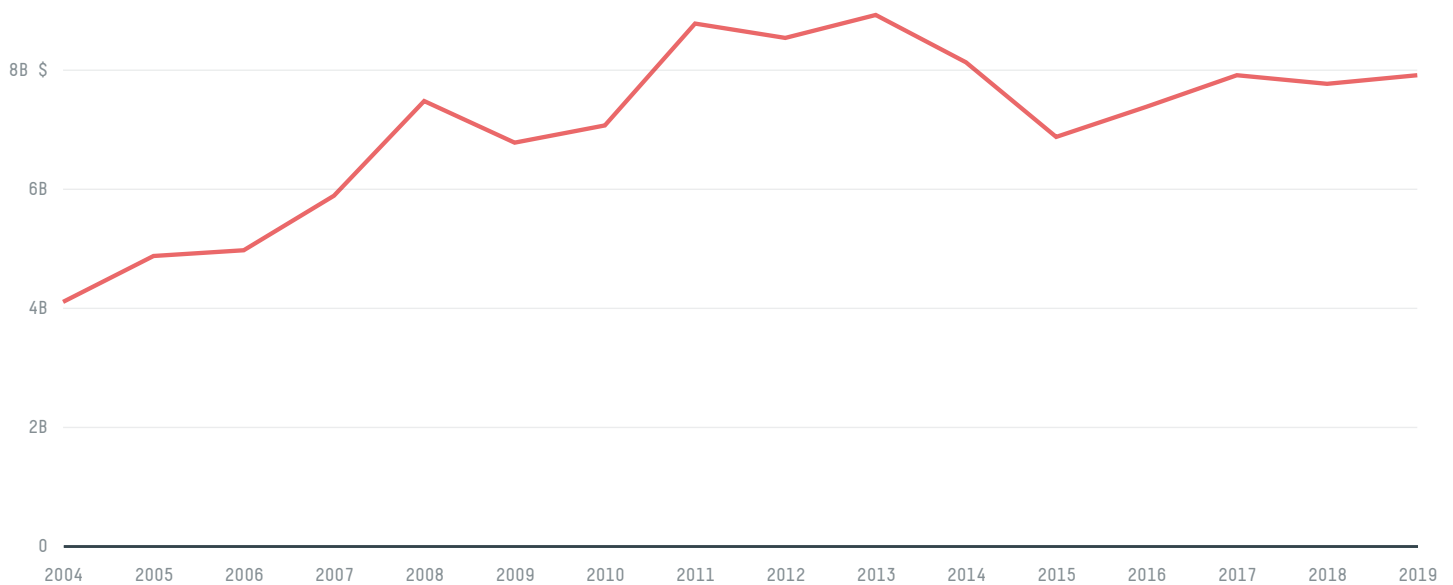

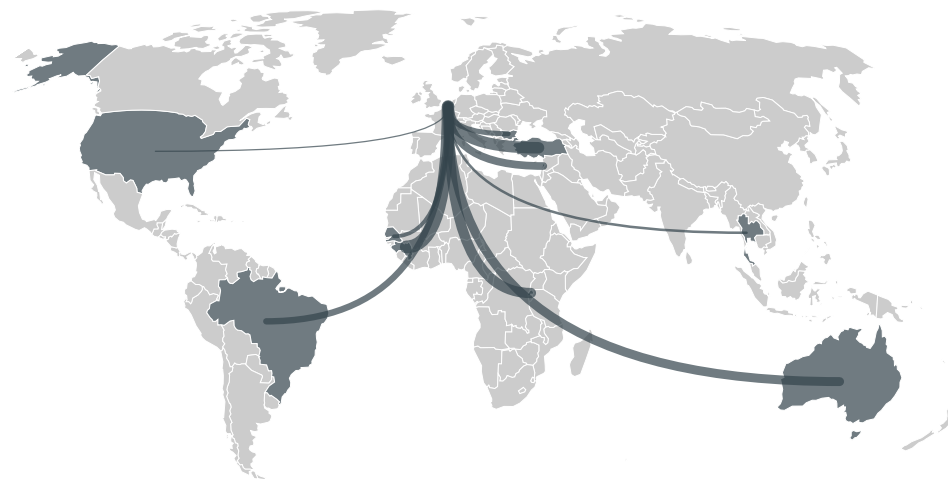
## IMPORT TRAJECTORY OF BELGIUM



## TOP EXPORT TRADERS OF CORN IN BELGIUM IN 2018



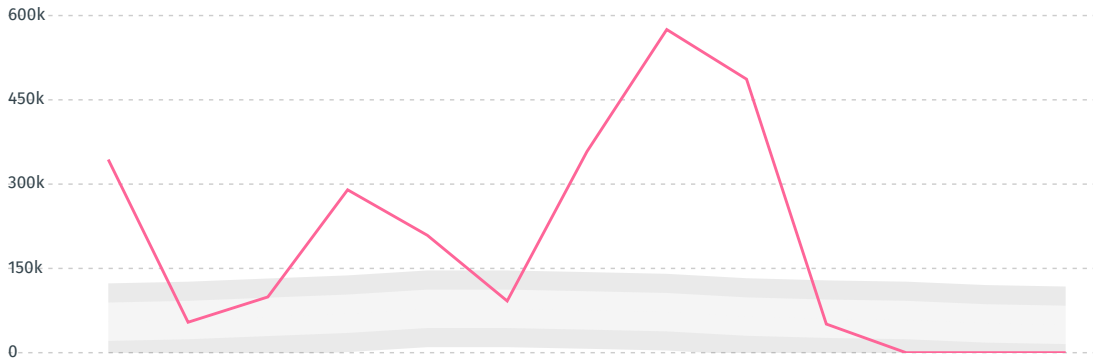
