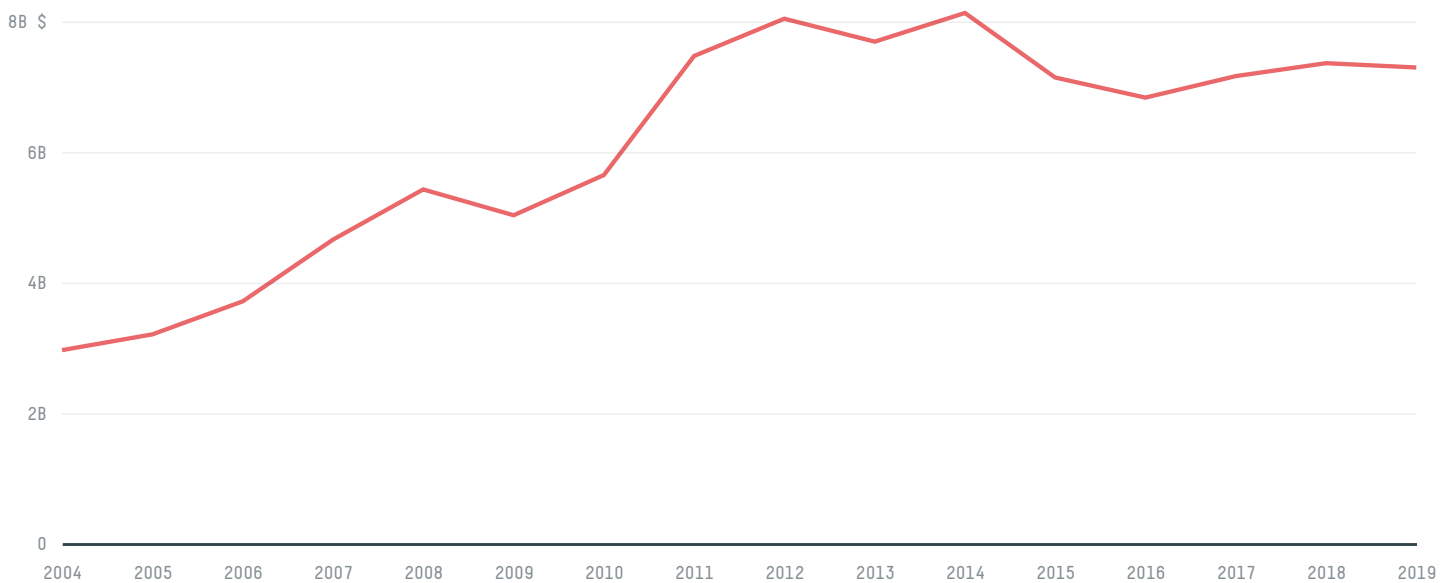

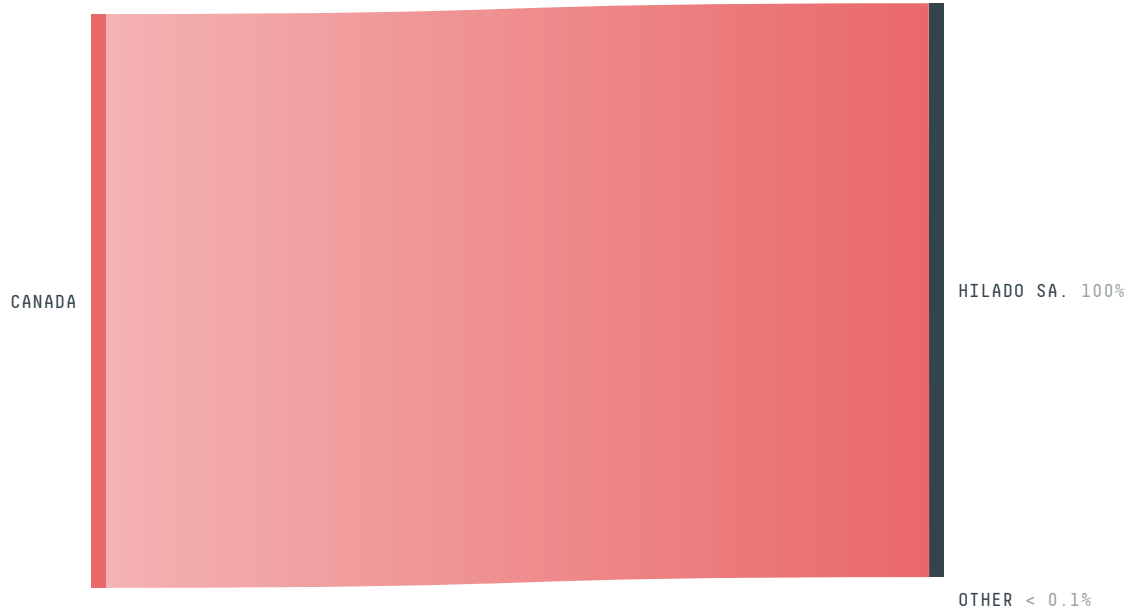

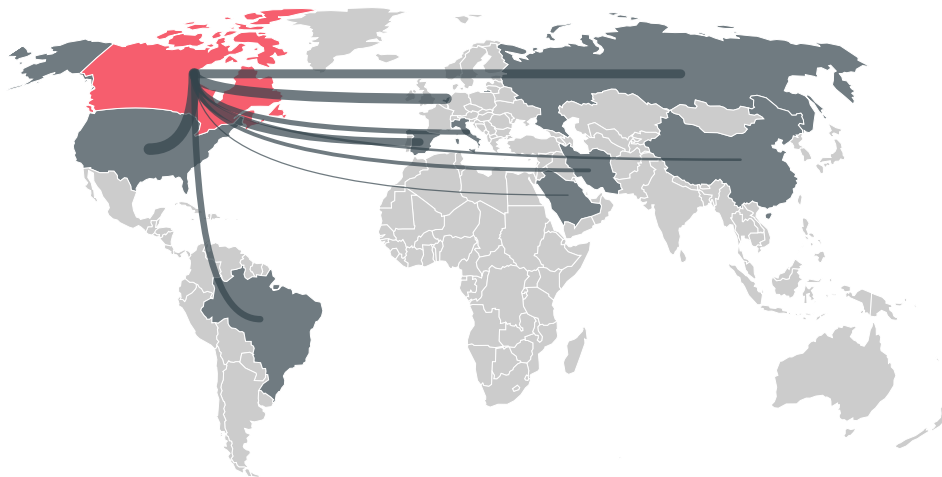
## IMPORT TRAJECTORY OF CANADA



## TOP EXPORT TRADERS OF COTTON IN CANADA IN 2013



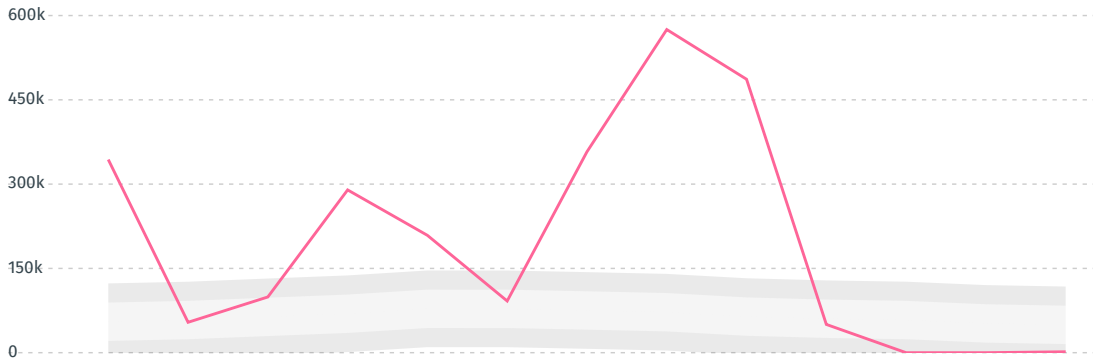
