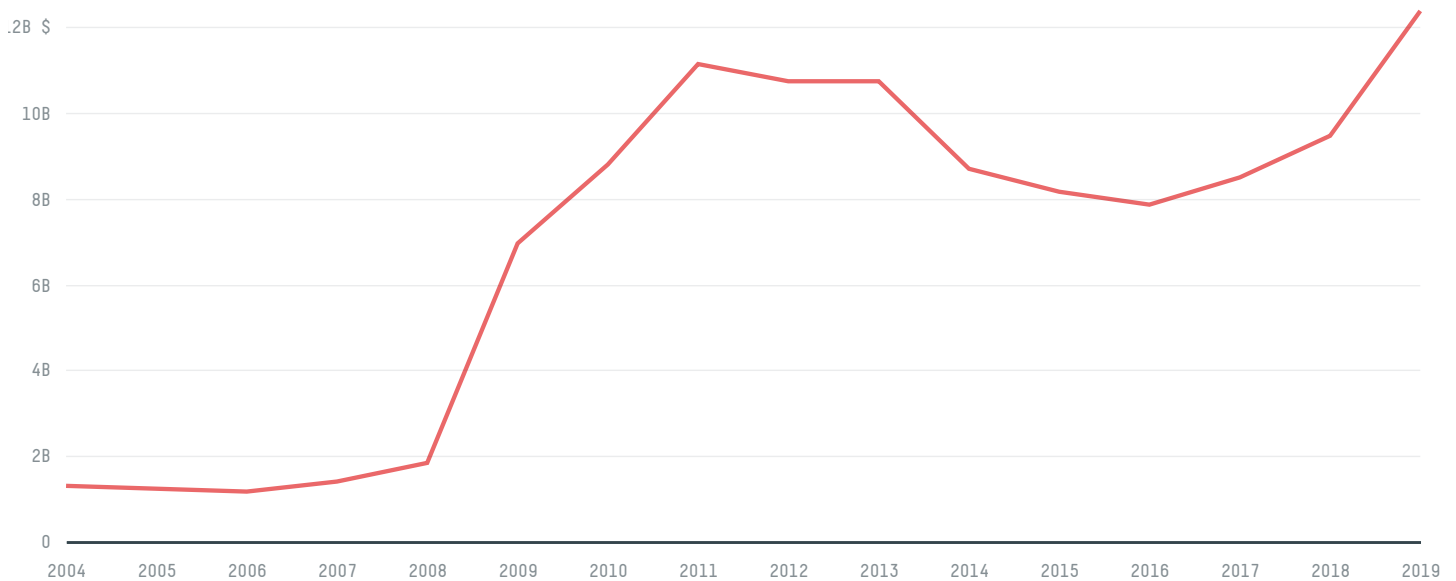

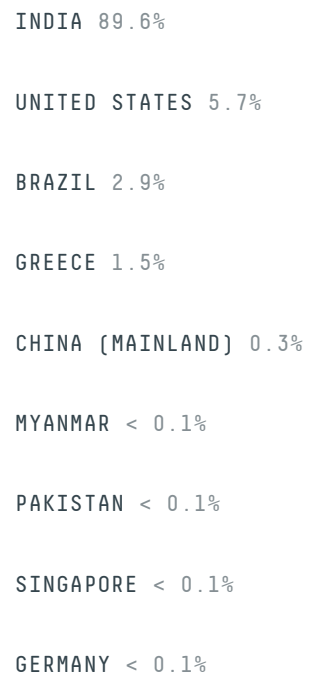
## IMPORT TRAJECTORY OF SOUTH KOREA



## TOP EXPORT TRADERS OF COTTON IN SOUTH KOREA IN 2017

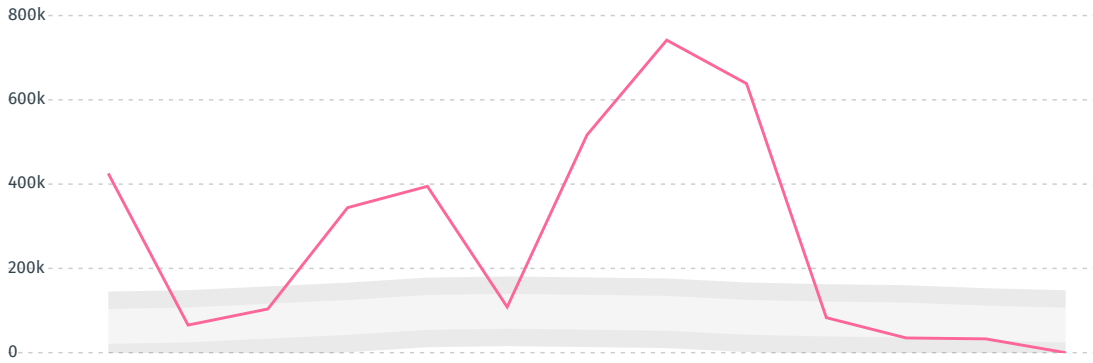


## TOP EXPORT COUNTRIES OF COTTON TO SOUTH KOREA IN 2017
