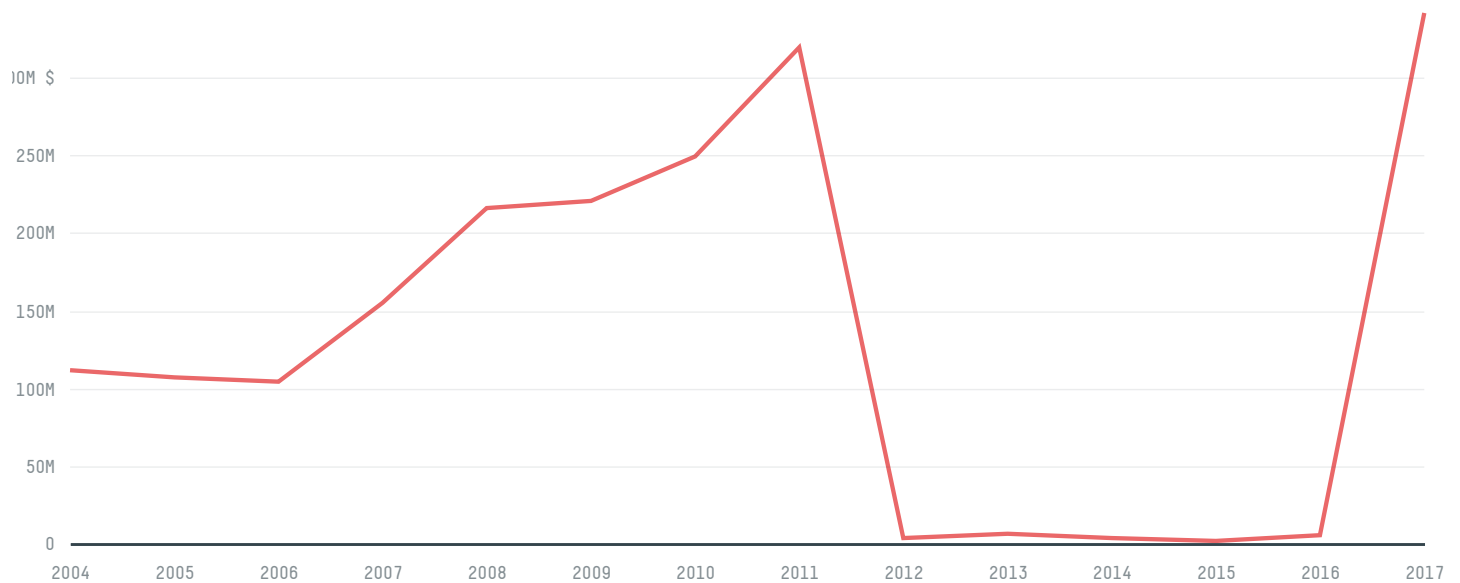

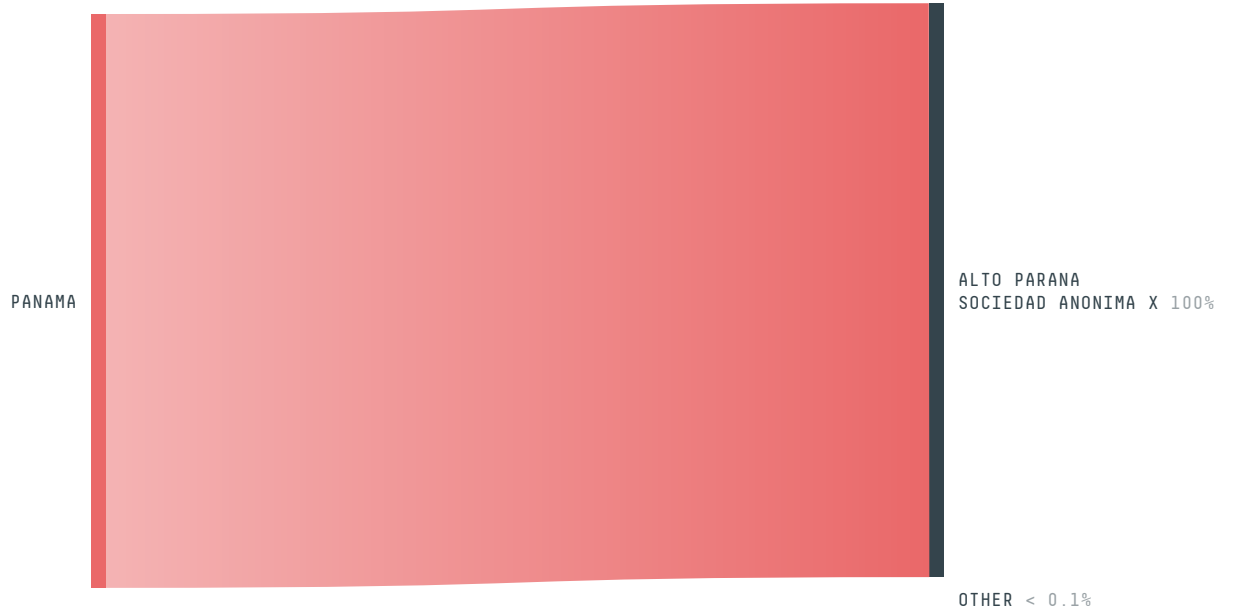

TOP EXPORT TRADERS OF WOOD PULP IN PANAMA IN 2015

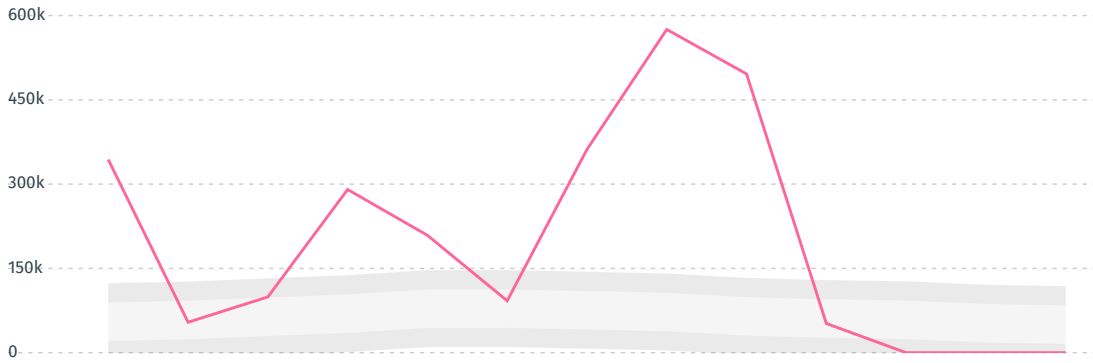


TOP EXPORT COUNTRIES OF WOOD PULP TO PANAMA IN 2015
