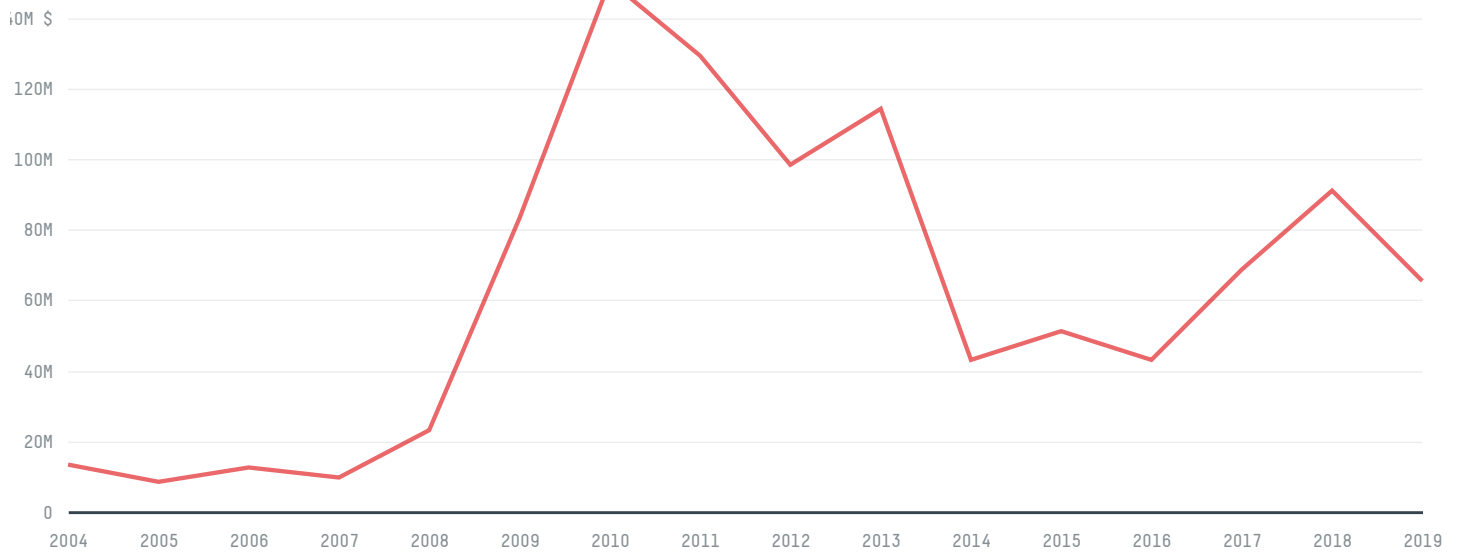

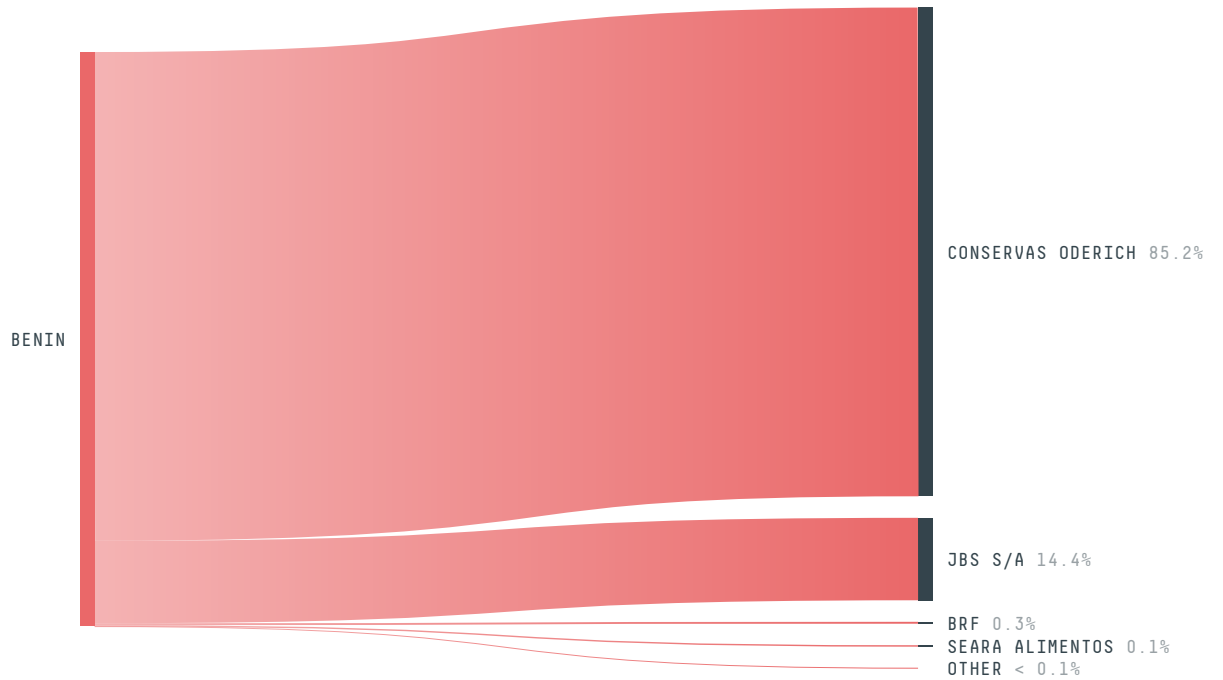

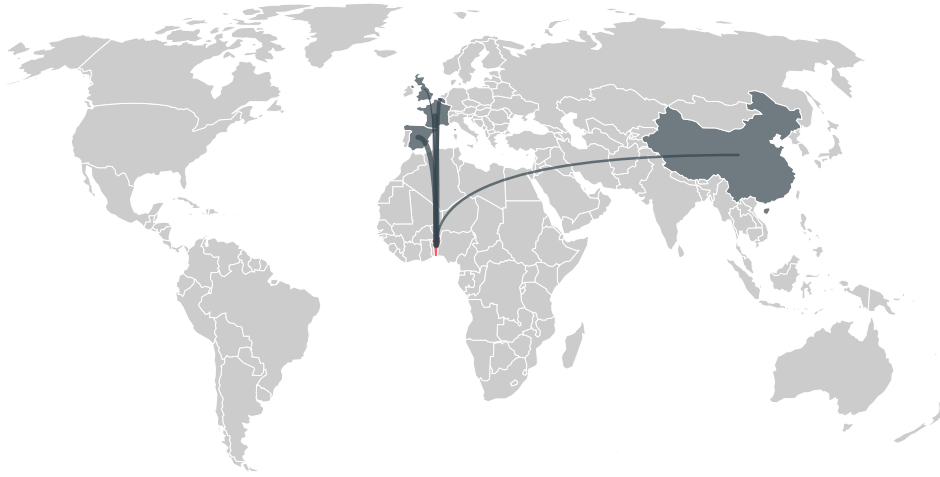
## IMPORT TRAJECTORY OF BENIN

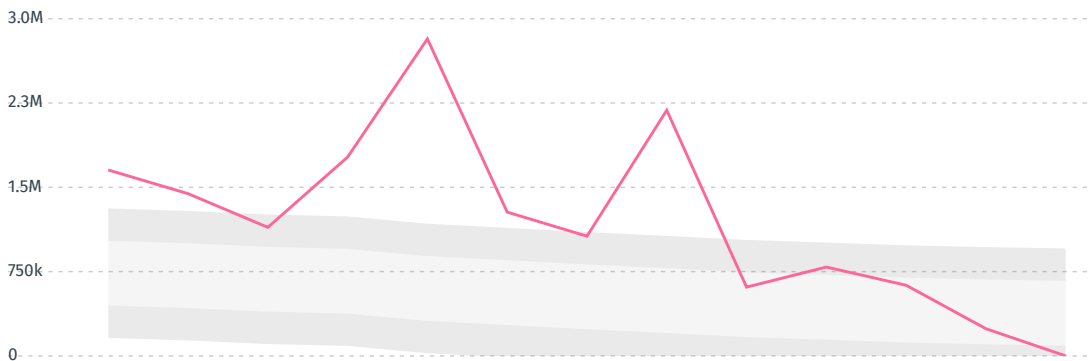
