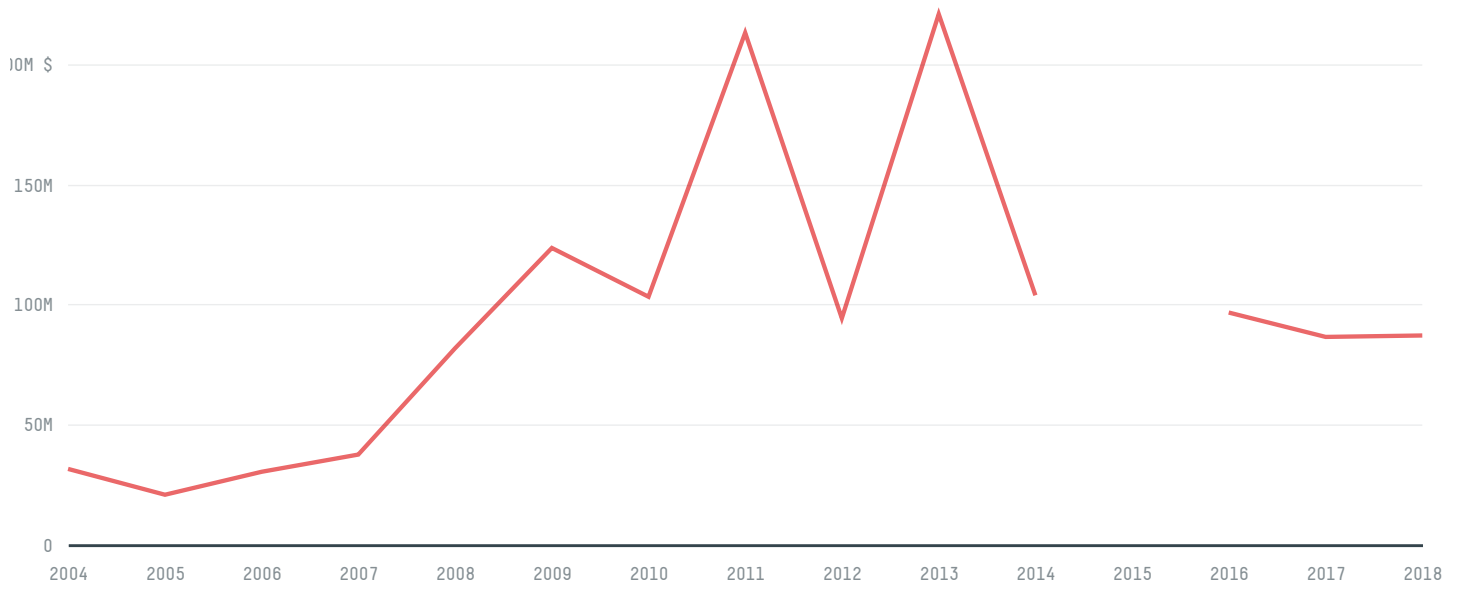

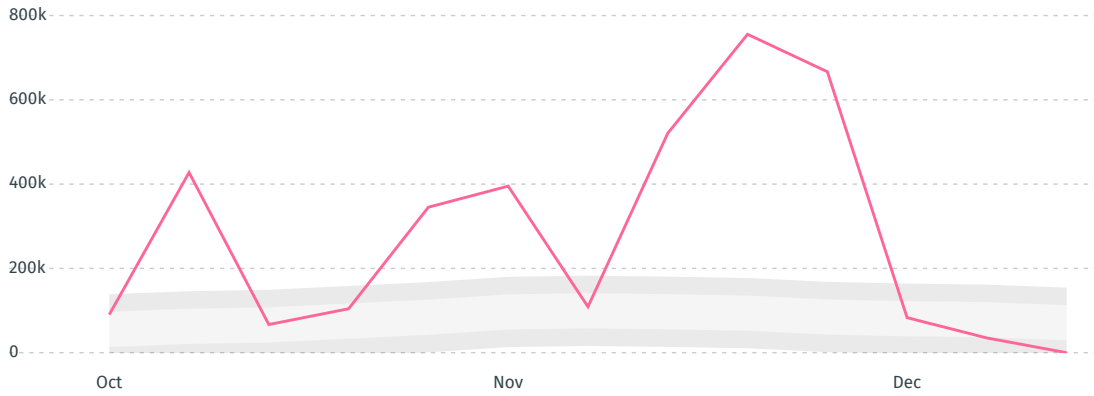
IMPORT TRAJECTORY OF MOZAMBIQUE
