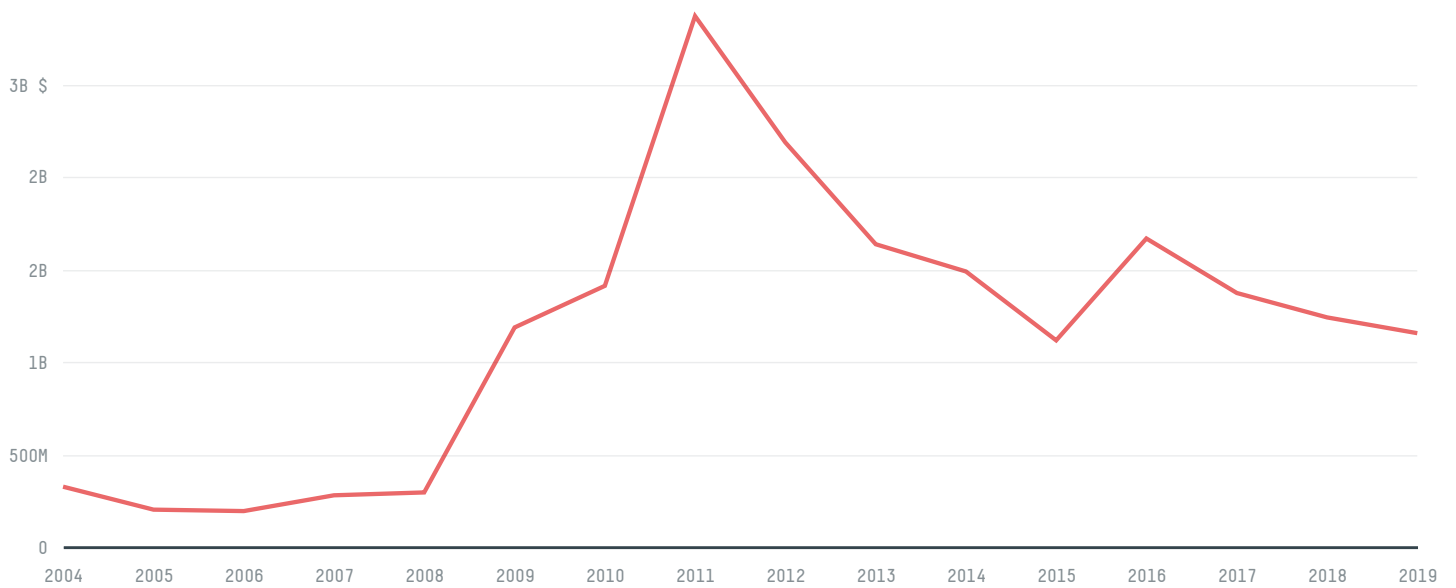

IMPORT TRAJECTORY OF BRAZIL

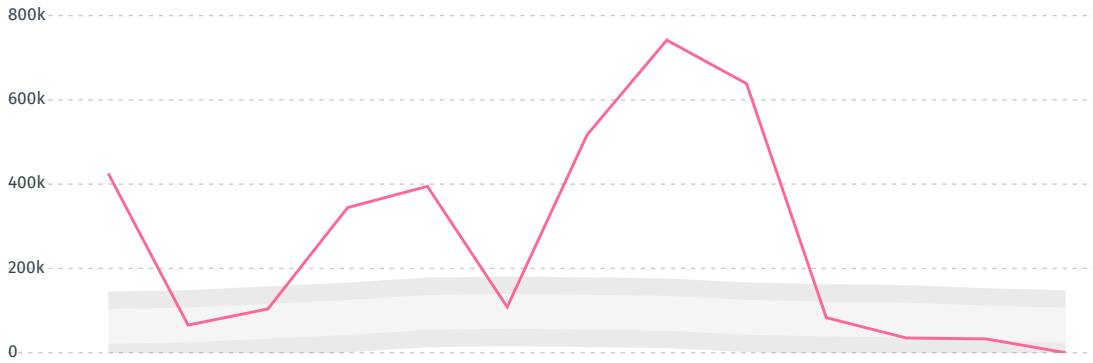


TOP EXPORT TRADERS OF SHRIMP IN BRAZIL IN 2017
