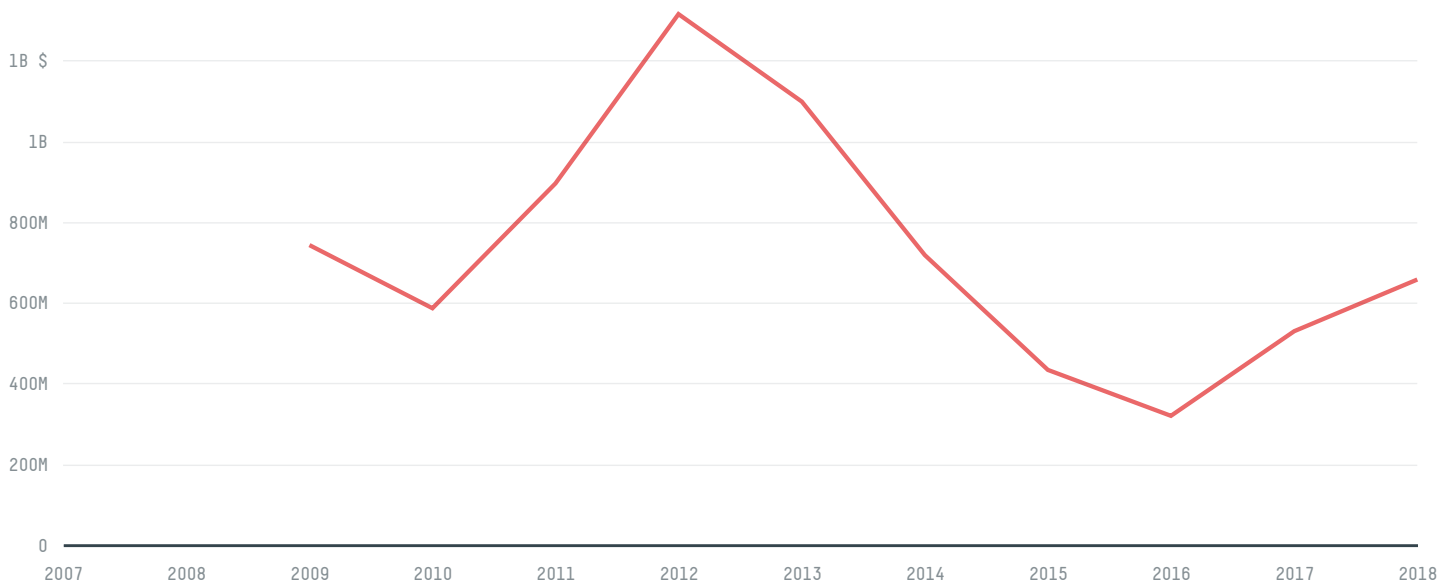

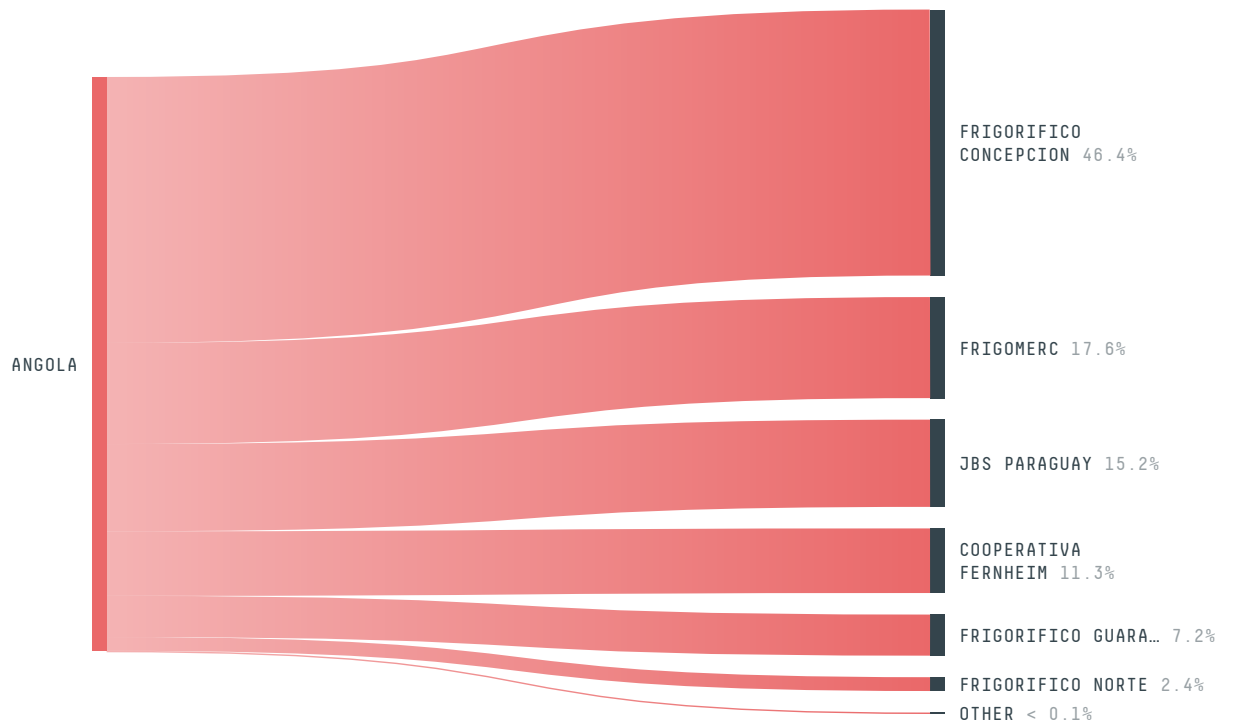

IMPORT TRAJECTORY OF ANGOLA

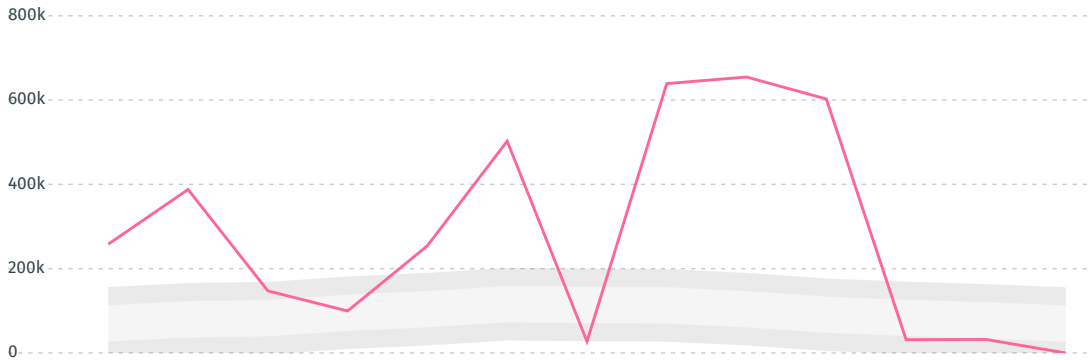


TOP EXPORT TRADERS OF BEEF IN ANGOLA IN 2018
